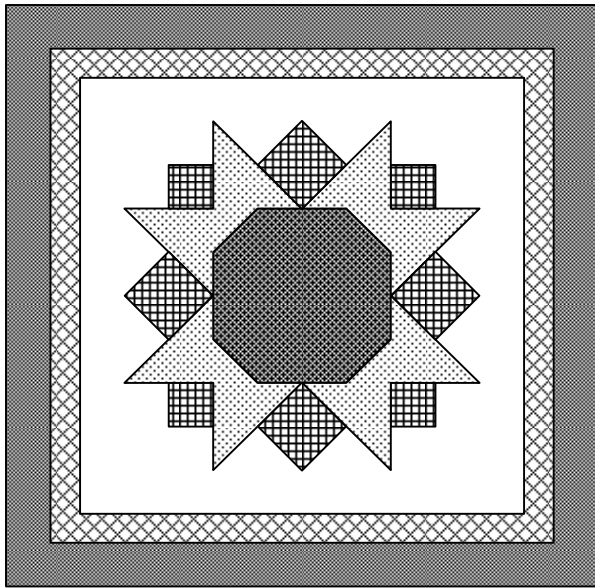



Sunflower

Sunflower 1

Finished Size: 21" x 21"



Fabric Needed:

	background	1/3 yard
	center	1/4 yard
	sunflower (color 1)	1/8 yard
	sunflower (color 2)	1/4 yard
	inside border	1/8 yard
	outside border	1/6 yard
	back	24" x 24"
	binding	1/6 yard
	cotton batting	22" x 22"

Note: If you want your back and binding to be the same fabric, the total will be 2/3 yard.

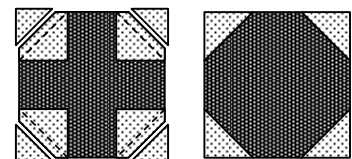
Cutting Instructions: (Strips: are cut selvage to selvage.

Segments: are cut from the strips to provide the pieces needed.)

1. Background - Cut 1 - 4 1/2" strip. Cut into segments: 2 - 4 1/2".
Cut 2 - 2" strips. Cut into segments: 2 - 15 1/2", 2 - 12 1/2", 1 - 9", 4 - 3 1/2".
2. Center - Cut 1 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".
3. Sunflower (color 1) - Cut 4 - 4" x 4", Cut 4 - 2" x 2".
4. Sunflower (color 2) - Cut 2 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2", Cut 1 - 2" x 9".
5. Inside border - Cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips. Cut into segments: 2 - 17 1/2" and 2 - 15 1/2".
6. Outside border - Cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips. Cut into segments: 2 - 21 1/2" and 2 - 17 1/2".

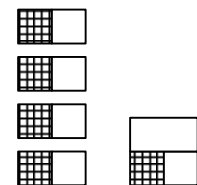
Sewing Instructions: (All seams are 1/4" - Press after each seam)

1. Center: Refer to Diagram 1.
Mark diagonal lines on back of sunflower (color 1) 4 - 2" squares.
(a) Lay sunflower squares RST, (right sides together) on each corner of center square.
Stitch **on** the lines.
Cut 1/4" from stitching to remove corners.
(b) Press back.
2. Corners: Refer to Diagram 2.
(c) Stitch 2" x 9" background piece and 2" x 9" sunflower (color 2) piece together lengthwise.
Press to sunflower fabric.
Cut into segments: 4 - 2".
(d) Stitch 2" x 3 1/2" background piece to top of corner piece.
Repeat to make 4 corner units.

Sewing Instructions continue:

3. Sunflower - Refer to Diagram 3.

- (a) Mark diagonal lines on back of 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" background pieces.
Lay background pieces RST on sunflower (color 2) pieces of the same size.
- (b) Stitch 1/4" on both sides of diagonal lines.
Cut apart on lines. Press to sunflower (color 2) piece.
Makes 4 HST (Half Square Triangles).
Trim HST to 4" x 4".
- (c) Mark diagonal lines on back of sunflower (color 1) 4" x 4" squares.
Place sunflower (color 1) 4" x 4" on top of HST.
- (d) Stitch 1/4" on both sides of diagonal lines.
Cut apart. Press to sunflower (color 1) piece.
Makes 8 sunflower units.
Trim sunflower units to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".

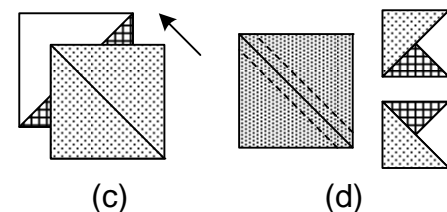
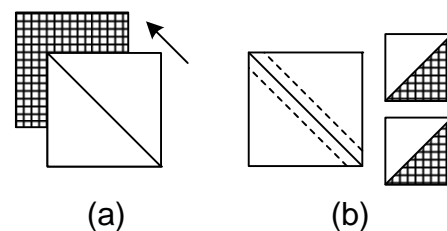

4. Construction - Refer to Diagram 4.

- Stitch 2 sunflower units together with sunflower (color 2) pieces next to each other.
Repeat to make 4 petal units.
Stitch 2 petal units to left and right sides of center square.
Press to center.
Stitch 2 corner units to left and right sides of remaining 2 petal units.
Press to corner unit.
Stitch to top and bottom of center unit.
Press to center units.
Stitch 12 1/2" background pieces to left and right sides.
Press to border.
Stitch 15 1/2" background pieces to top and bottom.
Press to border.

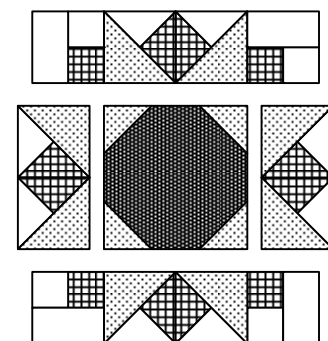

5. Inside Border - Stitch 15 1/2" border pieces to left and right sides.
Press to border.
Stitch 17 1/2" border pieces to top and bottom.
Press to border.
6. Outside Border - Stitch 17 1/2" border pieces to left and right sides.
Press to border.
Stitch 21 1/2" border pieces to top and bottom.
Press to border.
7. Quilt and Bind.
